**RE:** Change in acceptable specimen type for Troponin I (cTnI)

**Test Code: TROP** 

**CPT: 84484** 

Effective Wednesday, April 15, 2015, the laboratory service at Nebraska Medicine will no longer accept serum samples for cardiac Troponin I testing (cTnI). This change is being made to mitigate the possibility of false positives due to inadequately clotted serum specimens. Plasma (green top - lithium heparin) is considered the ONLY acceptable type of specimen for this test and other specimen types will be rejected after April 15, 2015.
